#### DIRECTOR'S NOTE & BIO

In 1961, *Black Nativity* became one of the first shows penned by a black playwright to be produced Off-Broadway. Langston Hughes' joyous holiday musical is a testament to his ability to blend his prose with his faith. This timeless work, tells the story of the Nativity through a combination of scripture, poetry, dance, pantomime, and song from the African-American perspective. Mr. Hughes' seminal piece has always served as a reminder to me that the Nativity story is one for everyone, all races, and no one particular race. Our production remains true to the playwright's intention of giving access to the story of Christ's birth to everyone and yet expands upon that theme. This Black Nativity is presented with a beautiful cast that consists of persons of all races, religions, genders, and orientations.

tony sanders, (who doesn't capitalize his name) is an award-winning actor/director/writer/educator/coach who has worked in film, television, video, regional and Off-Broadway theater, as well as, three national tours.
