Summary:

Affinity Groups play a vital role in fostering a sense of belonging and community among students with shared identities and experiences. The Affinity Group Leader is responsible for planning and facilitating meaningful discussions and events for students on campus. Leaders work in collaboration with Student Development Staff (primarily Spiritual Formation and/or Intercultural Learning Center).

Key Responsibilities:

- Facilitate regular meetings to foster meaningful connections and conversation within the affinity group
- Create a welcoming and supportive environment for individuals with a specific shared identity
- Organize events and activities that promote engagement and growth
- Represent group interests within the school community
- Promote affinity group events across campus through various channels such as posters, announcements, and social media
- Communicate effectively with group members and school leadership about upcoming events and opportunities
- Scan students at approved events for College Hour credit

- Strong leadership and interpersonal skills
- Commitment to fostering a positive and supportive community
- Effective communication and organizational skills
- Self-starter who can work both collaboratively and independently
- Willingness to participate in required training and events
