Our one-year model provides an opportunity to earn a multiple subject or single subject credential focused on equipping teachers with a culturally sustaining mindset and best practices to serve rural communities in Fresno County. There is also an option to earn a bilingual authorization in preparation for teaching in dual language immersion programs.

Program Support

- Grant provided stipend: \$35,000
- Full-year student teaching alongside an expert mentor teacher
